I noticed she was lame some time ago. Apparently she was either injured or perhaps she was even born that way. As I was feeding her I realized something kind of ironic.

I have a three legged dog. So he is lame. I have a cow that broke a hip a little over a year ago and by some miracle she survived, but she is very lame as a result. I have this kitten I just described to you and to top it off, one of my hens injured one of her legs about a month ago and is likely to remain lame as well. All of this got me thinking about Mephibosheth.

Just the Facts

- 1. Last year we saw over 1200 patients
- Last year we provided over \$500,000 dollars is medical care including medications at no cost to the patients.
- 3. Our total budget for last year including salaries was less than \$110,000.
- 4. The raw cost of each trip is about \$4500.00. This does not include replacement (depreciation) of vehicles and other expensive items.
- 5. Repair and maintenance cost us over \$10,000 annually.
- 6. We will spend at least \$2500.00 in Mexico insurance this year. This does not include the cost of insurance in the United States.
- 7. Transportation of the group is more than 50% of the cost of each trip.
- 8. While we are well known for the great food we serve our teams, the total cost of food and related items is **less than** \$5000 annually. For this we are able to provide 1700 meals in the desert where there is little or no infrastructure.

It is with deep regret that we inform you of a rate increase. With spiraling transportation costs, we are left with no choice but to increase our fees for medical trips to \$200.00. The fees we have charged in the past have never covered the cost. We hope this new rate will (at least for now) cover the cost, however, I must admit to you that this figure is a bit optimistic. We still want each of you to be able to go. So if this presents a problem to your plans, please let us know. We do have individuals who will sponsor someone if we ask. There is no shame in asking for help.

In addition it is crucial that your registration forms and fees are received in a timely fashion. We have been rather lax in this area and the end result the cost of a couple of trips increased dramatically. In one case we scheduled an extra vehicle to accommodate the team and when 3 individuals backed out we had to eat the cost. As a result we will not guarantee your spot until we have your fees. In addition in a few cases we have forwarded fees paid to future trips when individuals have to cancel. We will no longer do this as this practice defeats the purpose of a deadline.

Our fees to participants do not cover the logistical costs of each trip. Our administrative costs and the remainder of our trip costs are covered by private donations. If you would like to join us on a trip, or help with scholarship or administrative expenses, please let us know.
